On Monday May 17, 2021, District Lodge 19 will be hosting its 6th Annual Guide Dogs of America Southeast Championship Charity Golf Tournament at the Chattanooga Golf & Country Club (CGCC) in Chattanooga, TN. Founded in 1896, the Chattanooga Golf & Country Club encompasses acres of waterfront property on the Tennessee River. It boasts a championship 18-hole golf course, a swim and tennis center and a 50,000-square foot clubhouse with dining rooms for its members, as well as a large banquet facility.

Due to COVID-19, we were forced to cancel our event in 2020, However, our 5th annual tournament in 2019 raised over \$32,000 for the Guide Dogs of America. This great organization is a non-profit which relies solely upon voluntary donations. Every sponsor, golfer and volunteer gave back independence and changed the lives of men and women who are visually impaired.

Again, this year, there will be a Hole in One Contest with two (2) chances for a winner. The first individual to make a hole in one on the Par 3 Ninth Hole will win a cash prize of \$10,000; the first to make a hole in one on the Par 3 eighteenth hole will win a Ford Vehicle.
